

Data protection supplement for empirical theses (interviews)

- (1) Your participation in the interview is voluntary. You have the option at any time to discontinue an interview, to refuse further interviews and to withdraw your consent to the recording and transcription of the interview without any disadvantages for you.
- (2) Purpose: Preparation of the Bachelor's thesis of Julia Hager.

(4) Personal data:

- a) The personal data collected from you will be processed in anonymised form.
- b) Personal contact data will be stored separately from interview data and will not be accessible to third parties.
- c) All personal data will be deleted after the Bachelor thesis has been graded.

(5) Audio recording:

- a) The interview is recorded using a recording device and then transcribed by the interviewer.
- b) For the further scientific evaluation of the interview texts, all information that could lead to the identification of the person is changed or removed from the text.
- c) The usage rights (copyright) of the recording is held by the interviewer.
- c) The audio recording is stored in a protected location. Only the interviewee and the interviewer have access.
- d) The audio recording will be deleted after the Bachelor thesis has been graded.
- **(6) Publication:** The research results and the anonymised transcription of the interview can be published with the graded bachelor thesis.
- (7) Data protection: The data protection regulations according to Art. 15
 20 GDPR* are fulfilled. All processing is subject to Art. 32 GDPR*.
